

## **Deliverables/1**

*Pin-up: April 11/12*

Scope: FEW's technologies + site strategy demonstrated on a urban or rural 100m x 100m land parcel

### Deliverables:

- Site analysis: mapping of invisible forces – min. 2 to 4 gradient maps (2D and 3D) of larger site area quantifying natural or cultural forces shaping the site; chosen forces should be relevant to design strategy;
- FEW's practices: illustrations of selected FEW's practices, including technical and dimensional aspects, and case studies of innovative use of FEWs in architectural projects;
- Site Plan: plans and sections at 1/500 scale, including immediate context;
- Physical model: 100m x 100m site model with demonstration of FEW's design strategy at 1/500 scale (20cm x 20cm);
- Documentation of design process: diagrams, illustrations, maps, intermediate design steps, research material, including photographic documentation of physical models;

### Format

Drawings: A1 or A3 (tiled) color prints

Physical models: laser-cut, digital printing, cast material, folded cardboard, other techniques.

Please note: all material should be presented in digital format – original hand-drawings should be scanned and printed. Please use InDesign layout template provided by the instructor to place content on boards. Deliverables must be posted on studio blog as individual boards in PDF format (min 150dpi - max 5MB each) in order to complete assignment.
